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CORPORA IN TEACHING ENGLISH LANGUAGE VOCABULARY (CORPUS-BASED L2 VOCABULARY TEACHING)

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ABSTRACT

Efforts have been underwent in recent years to teach vocabulary in L2 in Uzbekistan. This is due to the development of new "word-based" approaches to L2 training, the inclusion in the Internet database of language Corps, which includes thousands of dictionaries used in real texts. To teach L2 vocabulary, a language corpora can also be used as invaluable sources of various activities. What should teachers do to make it easier for their students to master new words? This article aims to answer this question by giving examples of a number of tutorials that show how vocabulary training in the L2 class can be done effectively and attractively, using language Corpus, with concorandans programs. The first part of this article provides theoretical information on the processing, storage and production of new words, and the second part provides educational tasks that help memorize the dictionary. The final section of this article shows how to teach students how to overcome vocabulary deficits.

INTRODUCTION

The revival of interest in teaching vocabulary after decisions "On measures to further improve the system of learning foreign languages"[1] and "On measures to effectively organize the popularization of foreign languages" [2] is associated with

two factors: 1) the presence of computerized databases of words (language Corps) and the development of a word-based or lexical approach in vocabulary. Over time, we were more focused on teaching grammar. But since the 2000s, the situation has changed dramatically. The task of increasing the vocabulary, which forms the basis of communicative competence, has arisen in order to effectively communicate, taking into account the need and demand of the necessary specialists, language learners in the fields of Science, Technology, bizness, medicine, which are changing rapidly. In Europe, too, the teaching of this lexical competence began to pay great attention to the issue and research was carried out [3]. In order to communicate with tourists at the level of language owners, they must have mastered a certain amount of Lexicon (vocabulary). We are talking about how many words to memorize and how to memorize in order for language learners to be able to speak a foreign language?", we have to answer.

Dictionary teaching and memorization.

Donesch-Jeso writes that by mastering Ewa 2000 words, readers can acquire implicit (unclear) low-frequency words while listening or reading different texts, as well as more easily determine the meaning of words from context [6]. This helps words move from short-term memory to long-term memory. Schmidt, R. the more the reader knows how to "control" words when performing various exercises and tasks, the more his long-term memory is strengthened [7] he says. When teaching through the corpora we offer, words are easy to memorize and text analysis teaches

students multiple word analysis. In corpora's analysis of the text, words indicate that while Green denotes words found in most of the original English, words separated by yellow denote not using academic English.

A corpus (in plural = corpus) is a collection of written or oral texts stored on a computer. This is to make it clear how a word or phrase is used in context by truthful speakers across different lists. 

Below, one can see the total (all) use of the word tourism 1,410 times, of which in speech (spoken) 1,410 times, in cinema (fiction) 24 times, in magazine (magazine) 128, in Newspaper (newspaper) 226, in non-academic case (non-academic) 452, in academic (academic) 99, in others (miscellaneous) 440 times.


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After students learn to work with words, it is their turn to work with texts and learn to analyze them, a process that helps them to memorize many new words and communicate like real Englishmen. After the text is given to the analysis, it appears separated by colors. *These kind of literature should be prepared for all directions as well as for medical students*.

The color blue denotes words that are often used in English.For example should have belongs to the 500 most commonly used words. In our text, 44% of words are among the words used acadimically.

Green denotes 12% of words used on average and yellow denotes 22% of words used sparingly. In the text, one can see that the word tourism is used less than 2 times, the professional word on average 2 times, the artikli the most 14 times.



Now, by clicking on the word tourism from this text, we can also analyze its synonyms, finds, collocations, words related to it.

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Conclusion
